The U.S. has sent more troops to Poland
after an American soldier was killed and
another wounded in an attack in a northern
part of the country. Six U.S. troops were
killed in a shooting on Monday and a
further seven were wounded, U.S. officials
said on Tuesday. It was not immediately
clear whether it was an accident or whether
it was targeted. A Reuters photographer
and an Associated Press reporter saw four
U.S. personnel in the military base, after
which three local soldiers were at the

scene. “The personnel were in a facility under the control of the military at one of the units,” said one U.S. military official. “Two of the casualties were killed by the shooter and another was injured by gunfire.” The Reuters photographer saw U.S. troops being carried away for treatment on stretchers.
