Streets of Rage is a side scrolling beatemup developed by Sega and published by Sega in arcades in 1990. The game was hugely popular, and was often cited as a major influence on the 1990s beatemup boom. It was released for the Sega Mega Drive/Genesis in Japan on December 6, 1990, in Europe on June 8, 1991, and in North America on October 1, 1991. Many games have been released on the PC, most of which were bundled with a hardware upgrade, though many were not. The remakes of Streets of Rage 1 and 2, however, were released as stand-alone games. Sega has released several update patches since the initial game release, with Streets of Rage 3 being the first. Some of the possible issues are One of the four characters, Gouga, is not playable during the first few stages. This is a reference to the final boss of Streets of Rage 2, where you have to survive a round of continuous fire. During this round, Gouga is not playable, and will not appear again until after the final boss stage. When Gouga is not playable, a large chunk of the game is inaccessible, since there are a number of doors in the world that can be opened by pressing the "Open door" button. One of the dead ends in the game is located next to a store that you can buy an "Arcane Lens," which reveals the secret doors. Theres no way to get to it, but theres a small hidden area where the Arcane Lens is sitting on the floor. One of the characters, Kouga, has a limited life meter. Once you lose all of your lives, the game ends. This is a reference to Streets of Rage 2, where there is a similar limit on one of the characters, Yoshio, on a later stage, after which the game will end.



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
